

## **BOARD AND MC ACTIVITY FOR THE MONTH OF MARCH 2018**

1. The document committee completed their review of the Covenants, Articles of Incorporation and By-Laws and have been sent the proposed revisions on to the Board for comment.
2. The dead canary tree at the pool has been removed and treatment started on the remaining three trees.
3. Brown's Tree Service trimmed many of the palm trees in the community in addition to cutting back the hedge in Rivendell Park.
4. The Pool Project did start on March 19<sup>th</sup> as scheduled and is expected to be completed on time which would be the 1<sup>st</sup> of May.
5. There have been a number of meetings on Community Policy that when finalized will be posted on the web-site for everyone to have access. This would include non-compliance, fines, annual assessments, etc.
6. The Communication Committee has been in discussion on best ways to provide information to the community and to gather information needed to alert community members in an emergency.
7. The revitalization plan for the Rivendell Bridge Project is complete and is expected to be implemented the coming weeks.
8. Trespassing, including non-resident fishing, is under review to consider how to deal with this issue.
