

Board and MC Activity for July/August 2018

1. The revised documents have been finalized and plans are in place to distribute the information in preparation for a community vote.
2. The building at the swimming pool has been re-plumbed as a result of leaks in the original copper pipes.
3. GreenTopps trimmed and lifted all the oak trees on Butterfly Park. In addition, they trimmed palms along Rivendell Blvd and various trees next to Osprey, Crane Pond and Mallard Marsh.
4. Egret Pond was established as a pilot project to control erosion. The banks of the pond will no longer be mowed to keep heavy equipment away from the Ponds edge. Vegetation will be allowed to grow to a height of twelve inches and maintained. Bobcat Pond has been selected as the next project. Aquatic plants will be planted along the shorelines in the spring of 2019.
5. Landscape Lighting has been replaced at various locations within the community.
6. The solar heater leaks have been repaired and a heater motor/fan on the electric heater replaced at the pool.
7. Additional plantings were placed at the Old Venice and Park Trace entrance as well as several places along Rivendell Blvd.
8. Bids have been obtained to upgrade the main irrigation pump station along with removing the shed.
9. Additional plans and proposals have been obtained for the bridge revitalization project.
